

**Conditions of entry ... (Bamboo – Dried Materials)**

02. **Bamboo** must be free of soil, Plant debris and adhering soft tissues.
03. Only dry material will be permitted to import.
04. The consignment must be accompanied by a Phytosanitary certificate, issued within 14 days prior to dispatch under the authority the Official National Plant Protection Organization of the country of export in conformity with the agreement of the international Plant Protection Convention, and with the endorsement.
  - i. On botanical names of the **Bamboo** including varieties
  - ii. On the place and country of origin of the **Bamboo** and.
  - iii. That material has been fumigated with Methyl Bromide  $48\text{g}/\text{m}^3$  for 24 hrs.at NAP & ART or with Formaldehyde (34-40%strength)  $2\text{ml}/\text{m}^3$  enclosure for 15 min before dispatch.
05. The consignment should accompany a fumigation certificate the names and the dosages of which are to be mentioned in the certificate.
06. At the port of entry, the consignment shall be inspected by a Plant Quarantine Officer.
07. If the consignment is found to be infected or contaminated by any dangerous pest, disease or weed, it may be subjected to treatment, to destruction or to other suitable method of disposal as determined by the Plant Quarantine Officer.

**Bamboo:**

Bamboo poles are free from *Puccinia melanocephala* and Timber pests
