

Conditions of entry (Contd ...) Dried Flowers & Herbs

2. **Dried flowers and Herbs** must be free of soil, insect pests and growing media and may not contain more than 1 % foreign matter.
3. The consignment must be accompanied by a phytosanitary certificate issued within 14 days prior to dispatch under the authority of official Plant Protection Organization of the country of export in conformity with the Agreement of the International Plant Protection Convention, and with endorsements:
 - i. On botanical names of the **Dried flowers and Herbs** including varieties
 - ii. On the place and country of origin of the plants and,
 - iii. That **Dried flowers and Herbs** have been treated to eliminate stored pests.
4. **Dried flowers and Herbs**, properly labeled with the botanical name, must be securely packaged to prevent spillage in transit.
5. At the port of entry, the consignment shall be inspected by a Plant Quarantine Officer.
6. If the consignment is found to be infested or contaminated by any dangerous pest, disease or weed, it may be subjected to treatment, to destruction or to other suitable disposal as determined by the Plant Quarantine Officer.
7. A certificate from an accredited laboratory shows that **Dried flowers and Herbs are free** from *Salmonella* and *Escherichia coli*
