### PART I : SECTION (I) — GENERAL

#### THE CONTROL OF PESTICIDES ACT, No. 33 OF 1980

REGULATIONS made by the Minister of Agriculture and Lands under Section 26 of the Control of Pesticides Act, No. 33 of 1980, as amended by the Act, No. 06 of 1994.

#### Regulations

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Control of Pesticides Regulations (Sale and Supply), No. 1 of 1999.
2. No persons shall sell or offer for sale any general or restricted pesticide unless he has followed a training course on pesticides, the manner and mode of sale of pesticides and obtained a certificate on that behalf from the Registrar of Pesticides or any officer authorized in that behalf by the Director-General of Agriculture.
3. Any person who sells or offers for sale any general or restricted pesticide shall maintain
  - (a) a stock of such pesticides in his possession ;
  - (b) all receipts obtained by him from persons who sold such pesticide to him,in the manner as set out in Format I of the Schedule hereto.
4. Any person who sells or offers for sale any general or restricted pesticide, shall issue a receipt in respect of the sale of any such pesticide giving the details of such pesticide in the manner as set out in Format II of the Schedule hereto.
5. No person shall sell or offer for sale any general or restricted pesticide, to any person under the age of eighteen years.
6. (A) Every person who sells or offers for sale any general or restricted pesticide shall keep such pesticide in a separate building exclusively used for the purpose of keeping such pesticides :

Provided however, any person may sell or offer for sale any general or restricted pesticide, together with food and other commodities in the same building, where such person has taken appropriate measures to ensure that such building or portion is air-impermeable as such pesticide is kept separated from the place where food and other commodities are sold in order to prevent contamination of food and other commodities.

(B) Sell or offer for sale all protective clothing which may become necessary in the application of pesticide in fields in order to ensure the safe use of such general or restricted pesticide :
