To: All Pesticides Registrants Offering/Requesting Supplemental Registrations

Dear Sir/Madam,


Proposed Rules Guidelines for Supplemental Pesticides and “Me-too” Pesticide Registrants

As you are aware, provisions incorporated under the Control of Pesticides Act No. 33 of 1980 to register commodity pesticides are defined in two categories: viz. (1) Registration of the original products for indenting purposes, while leaving the entire importation & marketing operations for the indented registrant, and (2) Registration of the original products for own importation & marketing, while offering an extended consent for supplemental registration for importation & marketing by the supplementary registrant.

Recently, I have made to understand that some registrants have sold bulk pesticides (from the stocks imported and/or formulated in the country) for competitive parties in terms of “inter-company sale/purchase” without proof of a valid registration. Therefore, all parties are hereby informed to follow compulsory legal requirements of registration in order to avoid unnecessary repercussions. The guidelines proposed by the *Circular No. RP/2017/Sup-REG/01* is applicable for all original registrants and supplemental registrants. The following requirements are highlighted;

1. The original registrant is liable for any violations of product chemistry/quality even under the supplementary registrant is legally selling and distributing the product.
2. The detailed volumes/quantities of the product transferred (i.e. inter-company sale) must be declared by the original registrant along with a certified copy of the product quality certificate & relevant batch number(s) of the consignment. In this respect, annual data submission of imports & sales must be adjusted to declare inter-company sales statistics (separately) in order to avoid double figures. The supplementary registrants are required to report exact volumes/quantities of sale at the deposition of annual statistics to the Registrar of Pesticides.
